

CRAQ – 80th ANNIVERSARY QSO PARTY

To commemorate the 80th anniversary of the foundation of the Club Radio Amateur de Quebec (CRAQ) by Alex Lariviere VE2AB in March 1926, the club is sponsoring a QSO Party on the air in March 2006. All radio amateurs can participate, and certificates will be awarded to participants submitting their results.

Contest period : From 0000Z , March 18 2006, to 2359Z, March 26 2006

Operating modes : CW, phone (AM, FM, SSB), digital (RTTY, PSK, etc.)

Bands : All amateur radio bands, except 30m., 17m. and 12m.

Contacts : Once per band and per mode

Exchange : Members : Name, member number (« 00 » for VE2CRAQ)
 Non-members : Name

Multipliers : Once per band (CRAQ member numbers)

Points : VE2CQ or special call VE2CRAQ : 20 points
 CRAQ members : 10 points (with CRAQ member number)
 Non-members : 5 points

Bonus points : An additional 100 points for CRAQ members reporting their results

Certificates :

- a) Best overall score, CRAQ member
- b) Best overall score, non-member
- c) Second best overall score, member or non-member
- d) Participation certificates for all stations reporting their results

Notes : Direct contacts only. No repeater contacts

Members to members and members to non-members only

Contacts will have to be made in accordance with RAC band plans subbands.
